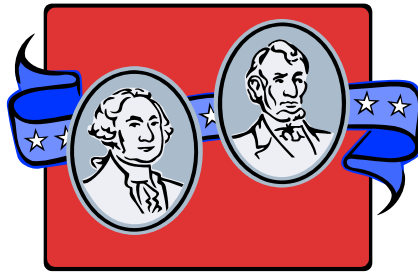


Second Grade News
