### Language! :

We are beginning a multi-unit on Vowel r syllables, such as er, ar, ur, or, ir. We WILL have a spelling test each week over our spelling words. We have been learning different vocabulary words these past few months. Each Thursday we have a new set of vocabulary words that we add to our list.

We are having a Vocabulary Parade which will showcase all the words we have learned so far on Tuesday, November 20<sup>th</sup>.

### Read Aloud:

We will begin MULTIPLICATION this week. We will be using SEMPLE clues to remember our facts as well as the Excel program to practice.
