### Language!:

We are beginning a unit on Final “y” sounds, as in *penny e* and *fly i*. We are practicing reading words with both sounds, and learning to code the words correctly for reading. ### Read Aloud and Writing:

We are reading Wind in the Willows. After we read, we focus on comprehension and word strategy. In writing, we are focusing on sequencing as well as sentences vs. fragments. We are using Multisensory Grammar to color code the parts of speech.



**Math:** We are working on Multiplication, up to x12. We have also begun double digit multiplication and an introduction to division. We are using the SEMPLE math curriculum and the work books to practice daily.
