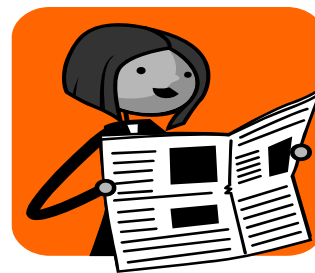


4th Grade Weekly News
