- ✓ **In Science**, 5th grade has been learning about *Matter and Energy*. They built a circuit and learned which materials are good conductors of electricity. They have also been experimenting with compounds and solutions by creating rock candy!

- Mrs. Corrie's class is working on: Least Common Multiple (LCM) and Least Common Denominator (LCD). We have also integrated this into adding fractions with unlike denominators.
