## Classroom Updates:

- ✓ In **Social Studies**, 5<sup>th</sup> grade has started learning the United States of America. The students are required to **learn all 50 states**, and will be practicing many mnemonics and multi-sensory study strategies for each test. Please review the letter about the Map study in the Thursday folder which includes all of the dates for the tests this Spring. **The test over the Middle Atlantic States will be on January 31<sup>st</sup>**.
- ✓ In **Math**,
  - Mrs. Corrie's 5<sup>th</sup> period class is working on multiplying, dividing and reducing fractions. They have also begun learning dividing with two digit divisors.
  - Mrs. Corrie's 6<sup>th</sup> period class is focusing on (1) division; and (2) setting up long addition and subtraction problems; (3) problem solving using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; and (4) rounding.
  - Mrs. Dietrick's class has been working on: equivalent fractions, decimals, percent and division.
  - Mrs. Gordon's class has been working on: multiplication facts and rounding.
- ✓ In **Language Arts**,
  - In Mrs. Corrie's class, the students have been focusing on descriptive language, using **adjectives** and **adverbs**, to create more imagery in their writing.
  - Mrs. Dietrick's class will be continuing to work in the Language! Program as well as multisensory grammar.
